| 5 - 6 | Cross rock left over right, recover weight to right |
| 7 & 8 | Step left to side, step right next to left, step left to side |

[17 - 24] WEAVE LEFT, CROSS ROCK, RECOVER, 1/4 RIGHT SHUFFLE

| 1 - 2 | Cross right over left, step left to side |
|-------|--|
| 3 - 4 | Step right behind left, step left to side |
| 5 - 6 | Cross rock right over left, recover weight to left |
| 7 & 8 | Step right to side, step left next to right, Turn 1/4 right stepping right forward |

[25 - 32] HEEL, HOLD, JAZZBOX, KICKBALL CHANGE

| HULD, JAZZBOX, KICKBALL CHANGE |

| Touch left heel forward, hold |
| Stepping down on left cross right over left, step left back |
| Step right to side, step left forward |
| Kick right forward, step down on right, step down on left |
